

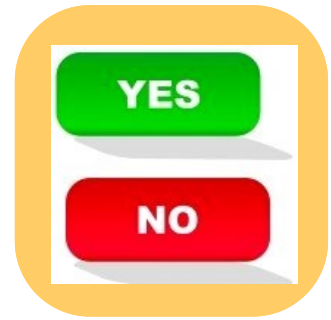
Brain Breaks: Yes or No

Equipment

- Classroom
- Whole class works best

Rules

1. Students stand behind their desks.
2. The teacher makes a statement that they do not know the answer to e.g. "I love strawberry-vanilla milkshakes".
3. Students who agree show this by putting their hands on their heads.
4. Students who disagree show this by putting their hands on their hips.
5. Inform students which answer was correct and any incorrect students are out.
6. I now ask one of the 'out' students to make a statement about themselves that no-one knows to repeat the process. This enables participation by those who get out and you continue until 2 people are left.
7. Once there are only 2 contenders, the first one to choose to agree or disagree forces the other person to bet the opposite.
8. There is only 1 winner.

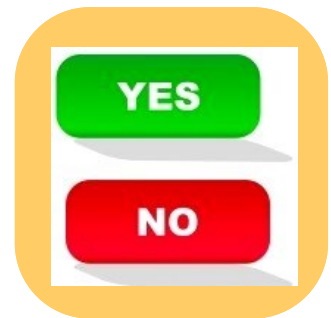
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
