

Brain Breaks: Alphabet Bonanza

Equipment

- *Pre-prepared worksheets with letters of the Alphabet listed on the left and a place for a topic title. (I use size A5 in the 5G classroom and have some ready to go at anytime).*



Rules

1. The Alphabet Bonanza is basically a take on the word game, Scattergories™, but in reverse.
2. A topic is chosen at the last minute by the teacher (choose something broad like; food, things that use electricity, things you wear etc).
3. Students have 10min timed to write an answer that begins with each letter of the alphabet.
4. Points are only awarded to unique answers so if two or more students chose 'Banana' for 'B', neither get a point.
5. However, encourage originality so 'banana split' is different to 'banana sundae' so these answers would be acceptable.
6. In 5G, students get 5 earnies (our classroom currency) for each original answer.
